# LIGONIER IS PROUD TO RECOGNIZE OUR TWO MEDAL OF HONOR RECIPIENTS SERGEANT ALVIN P. CAREY - AND - PRIVATE JOHN EWING

## Ordinary men, extraordinary valor.

Over 50 million have served in defense of our nation. Fewer than 3,800 have received the nation's highest military award, the Medal of Honor. It is rare for one town to have a recipient, much less two.

Private Ewing's courage during the last battle of the Civil War enabled him to capture the battle flags of the most heavily-defended area, the field commander. The flags that Private Ewing risked his life to capture effectively ended the battle. These flags ended up in the hands of President Lincoln, who exclaimed "this means victory. This is victory."

During World War II, in action in France, Sergeant Alvin P. Carey singlehandedly saved his squad when they came under fire from machine guns in a German pillbox. Despite being mortally wounded, Sergeant Carey continued the assault on his own, and eventually sacrificed his own life by throwing himself into the mouth of the pillbox with a satchel of grenades. Sergeant Carey's exploits helped influence a Hollywood movie starring Steve McQueen.

# MANY CRAFTERS RETURNING *for* FORT LIGONIER DAYS



If you've been attending Fort Ligonier Days over recent years, you've likely encountered Fred and Maureen Light, Leather Crafters from Lebanon, PA. "We've been here so long they gave us booth number one!" jokes Maureen.

Indeed, the Lights are located at booth #1 in the Municipal Lot, where they have been a regular feature since 1979! "Fred's sister lives in Ligonier. That's how we found out about Fort Ligonier Days," recalls Maureen. "She's still there and it's always been a big family weekend for us. Our four kids came along and now the grandchildren come every year – from Pittsburgh, from Columbus, from central Pennsylvania – some contingent every year. Everyone enjoys the parade, visiting the shops, seeing what other vendors are doing... it's a big fun family event."

Fred took up leather-crafting while he was in the Navy toward the end of the Vietnam era. He was looking for something to do aboard ship to pass the time and spotted leather working tools in the hobby shop. That soon became a hobby, and when the couple met in college, Fred was already doing craft shows,

selling belts and adding more items over the years.

"We really like it," she says. "There is a technical and creative aspect. It starts with cowhide. Fred buys the best leather and I do a lot of the tooling – it's a joint effort." All the belts are custom fitted, and Maureen demonstrates tooling techniques while Fred adjusts the belts. "A huge percentage are repeat customers," she says. "That's a great blessing for us" – and a testament to the high-quality products they make, she believes.

You can find belts of all sizes at their booth – from a half inch to two inches wide and in various lengths and colors including belts for kids. "We haven't found many people we couldn't fit," notes Maureen. They also make wallets, purses, leather caps, key fobs, zippered pouches, wristbands and other items – but no cellphone cases as there are too many sizes and varieties. "We don't do custom work and we have no website," said Maureen, "We really like doing business in person!"

So be sure to stop by their booth at Fort Ligonier Days and say hello.

**The Humbergers** – John and Billie – will be at booth #1 in the Fairfield Lot behind Commercial Bank & Trust of PA throughout Fort Ligonier Days. The jewelry makers started as craft show vendors at the Ligonier Valley YMCA and moved to the Fairfield Lot the first year it was added to the festival.

Their jewelry is all hand-made using sterling, copper, gold-filled, gemstones and they do all their own silver-smithing. “Our house has become our workshop,” says Billie. “We do no internet sales.”

It all started 16-17 years ago when Billie was looking for something to do and thought this craft would be good therapy for her hands. Soon she was doing shows and John was helping set up, so he decided he could help make jewelry too. “It’s been great for us,” he said. “We meet a lot of nice people and get to know our fellow vendors.”

Now they do a number of shows each year including the People Choice show in State College, Westmoreland Arts and Heritage, Memorial Day in Boalsburg, the Log House Festival in Westmont, etc., but Fort Ligonier Days remains their best show and closest to home. “Here they care about the vendors, and that means a lot,” says Billie.

The Humbergers invite everyone to stop by their booth in the Fairfield Lot during Fort Ligonier Days.

Jeweler/silversmith **Zack Landry**, a Ligonier native, will be making his third appearance as a vendor at Fort Ligonier Days with his booth White Sage and Sapphire, located in the Mellon Lot. His jewelry features natural gemstones paired with sterling silver and 14k gold fill metals, crafting pieces meant to last. His skills and techniques have improved over the past few years, influenced in part by an internship at Beeghly & Co. in Greensburg. “That experience completely changed everything and gave me a sense of confidence I hadn’t felt before,” Zack relates.

Early last year, Zack relaunched his business with a new logo, new packaging and his own website ([whitesageandsapphire.com](http://whitesageandsapphire.com)). He also began producing collections, creating designs that were visually lighter with an emphasis on layering while also experimenting with texture and movement. He introduced Herkimer Diamond and Layering Collections, along with Sapphire Stackers – one of his best sellers.

This year he quit his full-time food service job, bought a house in New Kensington, and has been busy showing his work at more than 45 events, introducing Evil Eye and Bloom Ring collections.

“I feel like I’m finally stepping into my own as a creator as my aesthetics continue to be refined, with both the knowledge and confidence to back it up,” he concluded.

“Fort Ligonier Days was my first large scale show and it continues to be my best event every year. I enjoy collecting jewelry just as much as I do making it, so it’s always fun to poke my nose around and see what others are doing.” He also enjoys the great variety of food available throughout the festival.





## GREAT VARIETY OF FOOD AVAILABLE AT FORT LIGONIER DAYS 2022

Heather Kaecher and Vic Smith, Food Committee co-chairs, report there will be no shortage of food, and there will be a great variety of offerings at Fort Ligonier Days 2022.

“All the spaces are full, and around the Diamond we’ll have a few new vendors,” said Kaecher -- including Pittsburgh Eats, – which just won second place in Pittsburgh for the best food truck – offering homestyle favorites and Italian cuisine.

Long-time festival-goers will be pleased that homemade apple dumplings and ice cream will return to the Diamond once again at the Simply Good food booth from Ligonier. Virginia Foods is another new vendor, featuring burgers. Firehouse Subs will also be on the Diamond along with a new custom cotton candy vendor.

Also look for some old favorites such as Fairfield Boys Club hot sausage sandwiches; Ligonier Boy Scout Troop 372 with their ham barbecue, ham and Swiss cheese sandwiches, soft pretzels and nachos, donuts

and hot cider; Antiochian Village with lamb and chicken gyros; Ligonier Township VFD (Waterford) with haluski, pepperoni rolls, hot dogs, cotton candy and popcorn, and Darlington VFD with their delicious roast beef sandwiches and frest cut fries.

Elsewhere, Aumer’s Sausage will be back, but in a new location – in front of Mack M. Darr Co. Inc. on West Main Street. Their hot sausage and Philly steak sandwiches have long been a favorite. Another dozen or more food vendors will be found in the Train Station Lot adjacent to Mellon Park – among them The Creamery at Pleasant Lane Farms selling cheese curds of many flavors.

“We also have a non-profit vendor this year,” noted Smith. Rescue Dogs, a food truck benefiting Light of Life Mission, will be serving gourmet beef hot dogs and fries at the Train Station Lot.

# THE STORY OF THE BATTLE OF FORT LIGONIER

As evening fell on October 12, 1758, British cannoners at Fort Ligonier, then known as the Post at Loyalhanna, blasted away into the drizzly nightfall, hoping their hissing, exploding shells would deter a raiding party of French and Native American forces from making more attacks. The shellfire had the desired effect, and the attackers slipped away in the darkness, heading back to their base at Fort Duquesne. The raid was in part, retaliation for a failed British effort on September 14 to capture Fort Duquesne. During the Battle of Fort Duquesne, also known as “Grant’s Defeat,” more than 40% of Major James Grant’s British force of 900 soldiers and officers was killed, captured, or wounded while the French lost only about 16 men.

General John Forbes had sent Grant’s expedition to raid, not fully attack, Fort Duquesne, but Grant had disobeyed his orders. Among the English dead was Ensign Charles Rohr, the engineer in charge of construction at the Post at Loyalhanna (Fort Ligonier). Upon hearing news of the devastating defeat at Fort Duquesne, the 2,000 British troops stationed at the Post at Loyalhanna hastily continued constructing the new fortification. Colonel James Burd of the Pennsylvania Regiment took over the duties of the slain Rohr. Late on the rainy morning of October 12, around 440 French Marines and Canadian malice (Militia) along with

about 150 Native American warriors from Fort Duquesne attacked the Post at Loyalhanna.

Led by Captain Charles Philip Aubrey, they first rushed the guards protecting the livestock that grazed in the meadow across Loyalhanna Creek from the fort. Burd responded to the initial attack by sending out around 200 Maryland Provincials, but they were quickly driven back. Approximately 500 members of the 1st Pennsylvania Provincial Battalion were sent to reinforce the Marylanders but they too, were driven back within the outer retrenchment of the fort. By this point, the entire garrison had taken up arms.

The defending forces made good use of the artillery that was being amassed in preparation for the drive on Fort Duquesne to blast away at the attackers as a damp, dark night settled over the combatants. The cannon fire “soon stopped their savage tones,” said Burd, and after a final assault failed, the raiders departed for Fort Duquesne.


The British claimed victory, but so did the French. While Burd’s forces had successfully defended the fort from being taken, that was not the objective of the aggressors. The French and Natives hope to slow down Forbes’ campaign: to take the French stronghold at the Forks of the Ohio, the ultimate strategic objective that had sparked the French and Indian War in North America and the global Seven Years’ War.



*Gatecrashers: The Rise of the Self-Taught Artist in America* is organized by the High Museum of Art, Atlanta.

# “EVERYBODY LOVES A PARADE...”

... And perhaps no parade in the Pennsylvania-Ohio-West Virginia tri-state area holds such an affectionate place in the hearts of the public as our grand Saturday morning event, the Fort Ligonier Days Parade.

Crowds of 60,000 and more line the mile of Ligonier’s Main Street and jam its historic town square — our beloved Diamond — to view a moving panoply of bands, floats, novelty vehicles (from horse-drawn carriages to exotic cars, trucks, antique tractors and far beyond), marching units, noted personalities, veterans groups and military re-enactors, a fascinating procession of the unexpected, from the heart-warming to the wacky.

This year’s Fort Days theme is “Honoring Historic Traditions” and this mid-festival ritual has become a tradition in and of itself. Veteran parade watchers (Some

with a half-century of experience!) stake out favorite viewing spots along the route, whole families and extended families share the parade experience, waving to area television personalities close-up, shouting a greeting to a relative or friend among the marchers. For all its size and glitter, the Fort Days parade has an intimacy about it, a personal quality that makes it all the more enjoyable.

One of the parades most cherished traditions is as a showcase for great marching bands. In the past, Penn State, West Virginia, and Pitt have been among the great university bands on display. This year some of the best high school bands from the area and beyond will be marching and playing. These include the spectacular Butler High School Golden Tornado band. A big band



(180 plus musicians) and always a big hit with the crowd, the Golden Tornadoes have been blowing into town every Fort Days since 1999. Talk about tradition!

Other large high school bands featured this year include Franklin Regional High School's Panthers, the Hempfield Area High School Spartans and the Morgantown, W. Va., High School Mohigans. Smaller, but big impact bands from area high schools include the Greater Latrobe Area Wildcats, the Jeannette, Greensburg-Salem, Derry Area, and Ligonier Valley's own Ram band. Watch, too, for the Philip Barbour High School band, all the way from Philippi, West Virginia.

From the anticipation as the crowds line the streets on Saturday morning to the exhilaration as the varied units begin their colorful cascade down Main Street at 11 o'clock, the Fort Days parade is classic small town America at its best.

### **THE GIANT EAGLE SHOPPER CHOPPER**

Get your double coupons, wait for the next BOGO and show up at the super market in this baby! You don't want this cart rolling into your car door. It's street legal!

### **HOW MANY BATMOBILES ARE THERE?**

Turns out Bruce Wayne was a car nut. There are originals and there are "originals," when it comes to BATMOBILES. But the one in today's parade is definitely one-of-a-kind, custom built with a definite Gotham City vibe from the original comic books.

### **PERCHERONS!**

We've got Percherons! These horses weigh about a ton apiece. They're big and they're magnificent. You'll see six of them pulling the impressive Spring Mount Hitch, from Tyrone, Pa. Look also for the Sher-Lee Percherons, from West Alexander, and the Ken Harding hitch and team from Bentleyville. Graceful and imposing animals.

### **HE'S BA-A-CK!**

Punxsutawney Phil, that is. The most famous groundhog in the world returns to Ligonier for a moving meet-and-greet with his public. Escorted on the parade route by his "Inner Circle," members of the Punxsutawney Groundhog Club, the "Seer of Seers and Prognosticator of Prognosticators" loves parades but will probably feign confusion or indifference to the crowd. That's just his groundhogian way. But wait 'til February 2, 2023.

### **A REAL RARITY**

Believe it or not, there have been more than 2,000 different cars produced in the United States since the dawn of the motor age. Here's one of the rarest of the many "lost" brands — a 1931 DeVaux sedan, built in Grand Rapids, Mich., restored by Bill and Carolyn Krall, of nearby Latrobe. Less than 5,000 were built and only about 50 survive.

Among the new vendors this year is **KingView Mead**, of Mt. Lebanon, which produces one of the most storied and colorful of alcoholic beverages in human history. Mead, made from fermented honey, dates back at least 6000 years. Before the Roman Empire, before the Pharaohs of Egypt, yes, even before “Hector was a pup,” there was mead — the “drink of gods” and ancient kings, with its many tastes (Wine-like? Beer-like?) and alcoholic kick from small to immense.


Other new vendors “of spirit” this year: **Rusty Musket** distillers, from just over the hill in

Boswell, with their own special Rye and Wheat Whiskey and a concoction with the intriguing label, “Apple Pie Moonshine.” **Hungry Run Distillery**, from Lewiston, Pa., with a wide variety of offerings from Ghost Rum to Peach Vodka.

In “olden days” the Ligonier Valley had its share of moonshiners eluding “revenooers” in various glades and hollows of these beautiful mountains. Now, things have “evolved,” as they say, and Fort Ligonier Days welcomes and celebrates these entrepreneurs in their craft distillery ventures.




